## BOOKING FORM FOR OVERNIGHT STAYS IN THE FORMER SMELTER SITE PARC FERME AREA

### PLEASE READ

We now need to pay the landowner for the use of this area therefore it is necessary for the Club to charge £10 per night per vehicle to stay in this area overnight. If you plan to overnight here, please complete the form, return and make your payment, (preferably in advance) or in person at the Trial Office in the Leven Centre from 2pm on Wednesday 26 April 2023 and you will be issued with a ticket to display on the inside of your windscreen.

We have been lucky enough to have had the use of this area free gratis for many years up until the 2022 event and we thank you in advance for your honesty when using this site as without being able to cover the fee we are being charged, we may not be able to safeguard the use of it for the future which means the event's future will not be secure.

Due to the risk of fire, the landowner has stated that:-

- \* Disposable foil BBQ's are NOT permitted but purpose built BBQ's will be permitted.
- \* Flying of drones is NOT permitted in the Parc Ferme area.

Portaloos will be on site and the public toilets will be available for use as usual. An IBC will be situated by the portaloos for safe and hygienic disposal of camper toilet waste. Please do not dispose of this anywhere else. A skip will also be available for you to dispose of your rubbish so that we leave the site clean and rubbish free. Please note that the Ice Factor is no longer open for business therefore shower facilities will not be available. Fresh water should be available at the tap at the rear of the Ice Factor.

Parking is at your own risk so please take care not to damage any property but in the event of accidental damage, please inform the Secretary immediately.

The area is only available for overnight stays from 9am on Wednesday 26 April 2023 until 1pm on Sunday 30 April 2023.

**If you are planning to stay overnight, please complete the form and pay the amount you are due in advance, if possible. If you are unable to pay in advance, please bring your form to the Trial Office from 2pm on Wednesday 26 April 2023 where you can purchase your ticket in person.**
