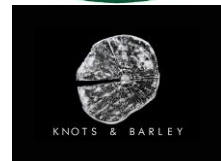

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IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Your bike will be marked with an identifying marker which must not be removed during the event as this will invalidate your entry and you may be disqualified.
2. **Riding Number Plate – Do not cut or modify this in any way.** Sponsors logos must not be defaced or altered. Please ensure you check your number plate is clean before entering each section.
3. Please stop your engine when entering the Start Area to reduce the noise level and for the safety of spectators. You should be prepared to start your engine when instructed to move onto the start ramp.
4. This Trial is being run under “No Stop” rules (TSR 22B). A stop, or failure, is considered to have occurred if:-
 - a) the machine ceases to move in a forward direction relative to the course. Balance, rolling backwards or moving sideways, whether the competitor’s feet are still on the footrests or not, will be considered a stop.
 - b) the competitor dismounts from the machine.
 - c) the machine passes the wrong side of, runs over, or touches a section marker, with either wheel, before the front spindle passes the “Section Ends” cards.
 - d) the machine or competitor receives outside assistance.
5. Asked for 5 - Any rider asking for a 5 in any section will be awarded a score of 10. This will be added to the daily total and monitored. If a rider continually requests a 5, they may be disqualified from the event at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
6. You **must hand in your route card** at the finish ramp each day, even if you have retired. Failure to do so will mean you have not completed the course and you will be disqualified.
7. Please remember to exercise caution when riding in the village and surrounding areas and YOU MUST always wear your helmet.

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FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. If you are staying overnight in any of the areas managed by the Club you will need to pay for your stay before you park. A person will be available at or near the entrance to assist you. Payment will be in CASH ONLY and you will be given a ticket to display on your windscreen which will show the nights you have paid for and you will be guided to a parking space. Please be aware that spaces will be tight due to permission NOT been given to use the former Smelter Site. **Please bear with us as we try our best to accommodate as many people wishing to overnight park in the village as we possibly can and please do not verbally abuse those individuals who are assisting us with this endeavour.** The use of gazebos and awnings are not permitted this year due to lack of space. Due to the limited parking this year, please ensure you park considerately and do not cause any obstruction.
2. Caravan/Motorhome chemical toilets **may be emptied into the IBC Container** provided in the vicinity of the Ice Factor/Start Area which will be clearly marked for this use. Please note that waste from caravan/motorhome chemical toilets **MUST NOT** be emptied into the Portaloos as they each contain different chemicals and we will be fined by the Portaloos supplier if they are found to be mixed.
3. Please **do not leave any rubbish in the village or camping areas.** A skip has been provided in the vicinity of the Ice Factor/Start Area for you to dispose of this and we do not have the manpower to collect rubbish from the camping area. Thank you in advance for your co-operation and respect for this area.
4. **No open fires or disposable BBQ's permitted** in any of the camping areas for fire safety. BBQs on a stand are permitted. Please be mindful of the danger of wildfires and heed any wildfire warnings that may be issued during spells of extremely dry weather to safeguard the countryside around the village.
5. Please **do not ride or wash your motorcycle in the river** due to salmon breeding.
6. Permission to use the land for the trial could be lost if you do not respect the countryside and we would be grateful if you could try to deter unauthorised riders following the trial on their motorcycles. **Unauthorised bikes and vehicles are not permitted and they are unwelcome at this event.**
7. Please remember that **NO-ONE** is permitted to follow the route of the trial with you other than your fellow competitors and authorised officials. Family and friends are not insured to be there and we do not have permission for them to be on motorcycles around the course. Competitors found to have unauthorised riders following them will be disqualified and any future entries may not be permitted.

Your co-operation with all the above will help to safeguard the future of the trial. Complaints have been received from landowners so this is not a threat but a real possibility. The trial's future lies in your hands so please think about the consequences of your actions – they don't just affect you!!!
